Refund Policy

- All credit card & check refunds will incur a \$20 refund processing fee. No cash refunds will be given. You may request a refund to your AMLD account to be used for future memberships or registrations instead of paying the refund processing fee.
- No refunds for memberships.
- Refund/credit requests may be made by phone, fax, or in person during regular business hours, M-F. Refunds must be requested at least 3 business days prior to the first meeting date of any registered program or activity.
- Full refunds will be given for any class or program canceled by the Parks & Rec. Dept. Programs and classes may be cancelled if minimum enrollment is not met or if mechanical, staffing, health, or safety issues arise.

Definitions and Terms

- Resident - Any person living within the boundary lines of Anderson Mill Limited District. These boundaries are depicted in the Limited District map located on our web page: www.aml.org.
- Residential rate/fees - Fees set for individuals residing within the Anderson Mill Limited District's borders. These fees are applicable for only those with a primary address within Anderson Mill Limited District. Proof of residency consists of a valid photo ID and current utility bill or other dated legally binding document that lists the Anderson Mill Limited District address.
- Non-Resident - Any person who's primary residence is not within the designated boundaries of the Anderson Mill Limited District.
- Non-Resident Fees set for individuals not residing within Anderson Mill Limited District's borders. These fees are applicable for all those whose primary residence is some place other than within Anderson Mill Limited District.
- Commercial Entity/Activity - Any for-profit business, person or activity. All commercial activity on Anderson Mill Limited District property must be authorized by the Board of Directors and/or the District Manager.
- Board of Directors - The Anderson Mill Limited District Board of Directors consists of 5 elected members. Each director serves a term of 4 years. Board meetings are held once a month on the second Thursday at the Community Center. Meeting agendas are posted on the web site, at the Community Center and other required locations at least 72 hours prior to the meeting. All Anderson Mill Limited District residents are encouraged to attend the meetings and get involved in their neighborhood.

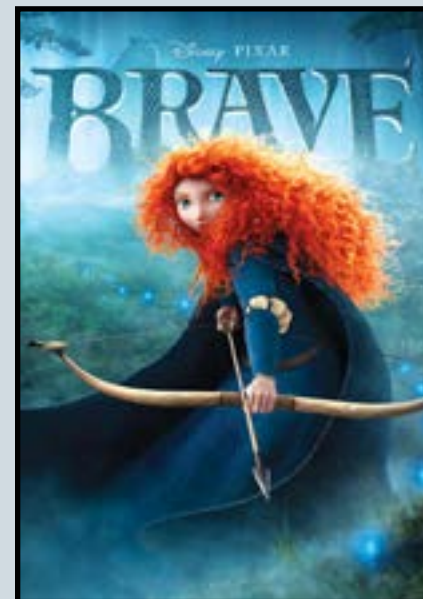

Cleaning Fee (optional): \$75 for the first room and \$40 for each additional room.

The AMLD Community Center is a great place for wedding receptions, birthday parties, and private events. Three rooms and a kitchen are available that can be separated or used as one large room, depending on the activities already scheduled by AMLD. Bathrooms and wifi are available as well.

- All reservations must be made at least 2 weeks in advance.
- Rentals must be for a minimum of 3 hours on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.
- A facility attendant is mandatory for rentals booked outside of regular office hours. This fee is included in the hourly rate.
- A security guard is mandatory for rentals when alcohol is sold or served.
- Payment in full is required when reservation is booked.
- A \$500 damage deposit is required 72 hours prior to the rental date. This deposit is a credit card hold and will be canceled following the rental if no damage has occurred.

Cancellation Policy:

- Less than 10 calendar days before event: No rental fees will be refunded.
- Within 11 to 30 calendar days before event: 50% of rental fees will be refunded less \$20 processing fee.
- More than 30 calendar days before event: 100% of rental fees will be refunded less \$20 processing fee.
- Within 11 to 30 calendar days before event: 50% of rental fees will be refunded less \$20 processing fee.
