Day Camp Behavior Policy

All members of Anderson Mill Limited District's Day Camp are expected to behave appropriately at all times. Our staff will encourage problem solving and teach conflict resolution skills so that children can learn to deal with adversity in a positive manner. We will also encourage self-control, self-direction, responsibility, and cooperation. We expect each camper to be a team player, to respect him/herself, fellow campers, as well as personal and camp property.

Our goal is to minimize discipline issues in order for our campers to better monitor themselves. Bullying will not be tolerated at Camp, and will be addressed immediately. If any type of inappropriate behavior occurs such as:

- Theft, attempts to steal or Property Damage
- Verbal abuse of counselors or other participants
- Physical aggression
- Inappropriate touching
- Children leaving the camps premises without an authorized escort
- Verbal threats of harm or death threats

There will be consequences in the form of write ups.

We have a **3-strike** system in place. **First offense** will result in the parents being notified and the child being separated as the offense occurs. **Second offense** parents will be notified directly after the occurrence and will be required to immediately pick up their child. **Third offense** the parent will be notified for immediate pick up and if deemed by the director a possible removal from that week's program will follow.

We believe that open communication between staff and parents is crucial in addressing behavioral issues. If these behaviors are consistently noted on our camp behavior documentation forms your camper may be dismissed from one day up to the rest of the week. In this case, no refunds will be given for the current week
